Actions from last task and finish group (Jan 25):

- The good practice principles and evaluation criteria will be presented to the EoE regional SEND forum in March 25. The presentation will include an invitation to all for the community of practice
- The Eastern region parent carer forum has received a presentation from Sylvia and Julia and are supportive of the principles and agreed to write a family friendly narrative for local areas and local offers. The parent carers raised a good challenge on whether the documents have been checked for accessibility, and I will follow this
- It has been agreed through the PCF's and regional partners that the master copies are kept on the RIIAS
 website.
- The annual review audit has been shared with the DCO/DMO forum for their views and thoughts on next steps it has been agreed that the DCO/DMO's will further review and ensure all processes and practices are captured. The tool will be finalised and included within the toolkit; local areas can then utilise when appropriate for their area.
- The good practice principles are going to be included in the SEND Independent chairs quality improvement toolkit
- I have emailed what works in SEND to offer the principles as a case study.
